Palm Sunday - Jesus triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

Maundy Thursday - (Maundy means mandate or commandment) The disciples and Jesus arrive at the upper room and enjoy the Last Supper (Passover meal) together. Jesus washes the disciples feet, as a demonstration of serving others. The greatest commandment = Love God, and the second greatest commandment = Love others embodies this evening. (Matthew 22:37-39)

- After the last supper, Jesus prayed in the garden of Gethsemane and immediately afterward was betrayed by Judas and arrested. (Matthew 26:36-56)
- Jesus appears before the high priest, Caiaphas, and the council (during this time Peter denied Jesus three times ☹) (Matthew 26:57-75)

Good Friday - This day remembers the crucifixion and death of Jesus on the cross. Approximate "time"

- 6:00am -
 - Jesus stands before Pilate and sent the Herod. (Mark 15:1-5, Luke 23:6-10)
- 7:00am -
 - Jesus returns to Pilate. Pilate orders Jesus flogged and sentences Him to die. (Matthew 27:11-26)
- 8:00am -
 - Jesus walks to Golgotha, and Simon of Cyrene helps carry Jesus' cross. (Luke 23:26)
- 9:00am -
 - Jesus is nailed to the cross (Mark 15:25, Luke 23:33)
- 10:00am -
 - Jesus forgives those crucifying him. Soldiers divide Jesus' clothes. (Luke 23:34)
- 11:00am -
 - Jesus tells a criminal crucified beside him, "Today you will be with me in Paradise." (Luke 23:43)
- 12:00pm -
 - Darkness descends. Jesus gives his mother into John's care. (Mark 15:33, John 19:26-27)
- 3:00-4:00pm -
 - Jesus says, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46)
 - Jesus says, "I am thirsty." (John 19:28)
 - Jesus says, "It is finished" and "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit." (John 19:30, Luke 23:46)
- Sometime between 3:00-5:00pm Jesus dies.
- There is an earthquake, and the curtain in the Temple is torn in two from the top to the bottom. (John 19:30, Luke 23:46, Matthew 27:51)
- 5:00pm -
 - Jesus' side is pierced with a spear. (John 19:34)
- Jesus is buried before the sun goes down. (Luke 23:54)

Holy Saturday - The day of waiting while recalling that Jesus was in the tomb for three days.

Resurrection Sunday - The tomb is empty. Jesus rises victorious over death, providing means for eternal life to mankind.
